AVSI, a non-profit organization founded in 1972, implements **development and humanitarian aid projects in 33 countries**, including Italy.

Our vision: to work for a world where the person is the protagonist of her own integral development and that of her community, even in crisis and emergency contexts.

In 2019, AVSI helped more than **5 million people in need**, including **23,872 children** through our distance support program.

AVSI main sectors of intervention are: **Education**, which for AVSI is the cornerstone of development, **Environment, Democratization, Energy, Agriculture and Food Security, Child Protection, Health, Human Rights, Livelihood and Economic Strengthening, Nutrition, Sustainable Cities and Communities, Vocational Training and Job Creation, and Water.**

On its last financial statement (2019), AVSI had annual expenditure of 80,475,535.82 Euro, of which 77% came from institutional donors and 23% from private individuals. For every Euro received, 89.97 cents are used to implement projects. Moreover, AVSI is an institution authorized by the Commission for International Adoptions of the Italian Government.
