SUPPORT TO VULNERABLE FAMILIES IN 5 DISTRICTS OF RWANDA TO MITIGATE COVID-19 IMPACT

2020 - 2021

The expansion of the Covid-19 pandemic in Rwanda has led the government to revitalize lockdown measures. As a result this has reduced economic activities with a negative impact especially on families in categories 1 and 2 ubudehe. In response, AVSI thanks to the action **“Support to vulnerable families in 5 districts of Rwanda to mitigate COVID-19 impact” (May 2020 – February 2021)** financed by the EU has implemented this project to reduce the economic and educational impact of the Coronavirus pandemic in rural communities in Rwanda

Activities

- Distribution of food for increased food availability in selected vulnerable families
- Cash transfer for increased short-term income in selected vulnerable families



- Education support for increased access to education provided by the Ministry of Education through radio programs in selected vulnerable families
- Production of masks and detergents for increased availability of PPE (masks, detergents) material in selected vulnerable communities due to an increased local production

Objectives

- The Overall objective is to reduce the economic and educational impact of the Coronavirus pandemic in rural communities in Rwanda reaching 1,824 families.
- The Specific objective is to support vulnerable families in having access to additional resources to mitigate the impact of the virus in the Districts of Gatsibo, Gicumbi, Kamonyi, Ruhango and Nyanza
